Schramsberg vineyard is one of the oldest wineries in the Napa Valley, established in 1862. Schramsberg has been served at official functions by every U.S. Presidential Administration since Richard Nixon in 1972

WHITE

Saint Cosme, Condrieu	1999	France	£55
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The estate has been growing wine since the 15th century. The Condrieu is a viognier from the northern Rhone and amongst the very best example of this wine.

Barre A Mine, Pouilly Fume	2017	France	£75
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This Sauvignon Blanc from the Loire is of excellent quality due to its great balanced characteristics. It is vibrant, developed and pronounce and has a great fruit concentration and minerality.

Philippe Bouzereau, Mersault Premier Cru	2015	France	£138
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This Burgundy has received more awards than any other wine from the region. Genevieves is a Premier Cru rated climat of the Meursault appellation in the Cote de Beaune and tasting notes commonly cites hints of butter, almonds and grilled hazelnuts along with the finer citrus fruit and mineral elements.

Reverdy & Fils, La Vallardiere, Sancerre	2017	France	£30
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Sauvignon Blanc from Loire valley appellations od Sancerre ranks amongst the most distinctive in the world. This is an excellent example from Jean Reverdy which was highly rated from the wine critics

J Lohr, Arroyo Seco Monterey, Chardonnay	2019	USA	£40
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The Arroyo Seco in Monterey County just south of San Francisco was founded in 1972. Despite being one of the largest wineries in the USA is still family owned. This excellent vintage exhibits racy acidity, lively apple, pear and lemon, moderate oak spice and bright toasty note in the finish

Penfolds. Reserve Bin 15A, Chardonnay	2015	Australia	£83
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Beautiful Grand Cru Chablis – like with so much racing sea shell freshness and flinty complexity. The almondy creaminess adding layers of texture

ROSE

Les Petits Roucas	2017	France	£25
Its French rose made from cabernet sauvignon blend, as crisp and dry with a fine finish			
Rías Baixas, Santiago Ruíz	2006	Spain	£25
This wine from Spain has won many awards from a blend of Alberino grapes and represents outstanding value			

RED

Mitolo 'Reiver', Shiraz	2006	Australia	£60
This wine was awarded gold from the international wine challenge. Mitolo wines is based in the McLaren Vale wine region of south Australia. It specializes in red wines made from the Australian varietals. This wine has rich nose of dark plums and liquorice mixed with smoked oak, mushroom and leather.			

Amon Ra, Ben Glaetzer	2010	Australia	£95
Numerous awards include Sommeliers Choice has been won by this wine. Robert Parker awarded this a score of 97. Despite this wines weight and richness it retains a superb sense of balance and structure, Firm acids and tannins supports the blueberry fruit			

Mitolo, Gam, Shiraz	2005	Australia	£80
Ben Glaetzer has crafted this excellent wine for the Mitolo family. The bouquet of vanilla, spice and plum pudding shows a creamy texture and a touch of warmth in the finish. Awarded 95 from Robert Parker			

Montes, Cabernet Sauvignon	2011	Chile	£30
This is a large wine producer in Chile founded in 1987 by Aurelio Montes to produce high quality Chilean wine. Fruits are subtle and dark. A very well balanced expression and light tar notes characteristic of Chile.			

Felton Road, Cornish Point Central Otago, Pinot Noir	2008	NZ	£80
This is Pinot Noir from an iconic New Zealand vineyard, supple but structured and only the 3 rd vintage made. Touches of Hickory smoke and mocha accent the dark plum and savoury fruit			

Domaine Alary, Cairanne, Cotes du Rhone	2016	France	£50
This is a full-bodied fleshy blend of 50% Grenache and 50% Syrah. Blackcherry and plum flavours are ripe and ready scented by hints of black olive. 95 awarded by Robert Parker			

Chateau Sociando Mallet	2003	France	£70
This Haut Medoc is located in the northern Medoc and generally regarded as the equal of many classed growths. This vintage has been rated as highly as 93 by wine critics			

Jean Chauvenet, Nuit St Georges	2006	France	£45
Numerous awards has been won by this wine and one of the most popular wines for this region. A pure Pinot Noir which will fair well with duck and game.			

La Muse, Guillaume Gonnet, Chateauneuf du Pape	2016	France	£70
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This juicy forward wine is made from 90% Grenache, luscious and framed by firm densely packed tannins. Amongst the highest priced wines from Chateauneuf du Pape and rated very highly by critics.

Penfolds, Bin 23, Pinot Noir 2017 Australia £40

Penfolds is Australia's most famous wine producer founded in 1844. Bin 23 name is derived from the place the wine matures in Adelaide hills. This Pinot has been rated at 90 by the critics.

The Black Shiraz, Berton Vineyard 2017 Australia £30

This south eastern Australian wine is rich and intense, pairs well with beef and venison and highly rated from many critics

Lopez Cristobal, unfiltered wine, 'Crianza' 1998 Spain £90

This is a highly regarded Tempranillo from Castilla y Leon, Ribera, Spain, with many accolades from all the critics

La Rioja Alta SA 'Rioja', 'Gran Reserve' 2005 Spain £90

This mature, tawney, Gran Reserva with aromas of lemon peel, cedar and dried cherry is the epitome of elegance. Rioja Alto is one of the foremost estates in the Rioja region formed in 1890 famous for their classically styled spicy reds that can age gracefully for many decades.

Lismore Estate Reserve Syrah 2017 SA £85

This wine from Samantha O'Keefe who single handed created Greyton as an appellation in South Africa. This old world Syrah has lovely spice and blackberry infusion, a little tobacco and smoke, spicy pepper, cherry and liquorice with firm damson fruit. Rated at 97 by Tim Atkin

SWEET

Klein Constantia, Vin de Constance

This South African sweetie is reputed to be queen Victoria's favourite and credited for healing broken hearts. An explosion of every tropical fruit imaginable, viscous, extremely concentrated and completely coats the palate with a never ending finish

Chateau Castelnau de Suduirant, Sauterne

Chateau Suduirant is well known for the highly prized sweet wine made predominantly from semillion. In 1855 it was classified as a premier cru producer in the 1855 classification and borders chateau d'Yquem. Castelnau is the 2nd wine of Suduirant and made from the grapes that generally ripens earlier in the season.

Alvear Pedro Ximenez

Alvear was built in 1729 and amongst the longest and best known producers in Andalucia. This outstanding vintage opens with aromas of burnt apricot, orange rind, caramel and simmering brown sugar and its been rated very very highly by the critics.
